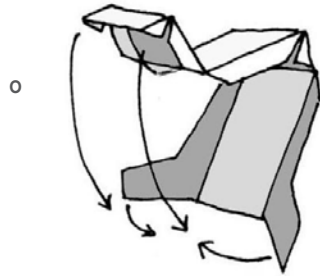
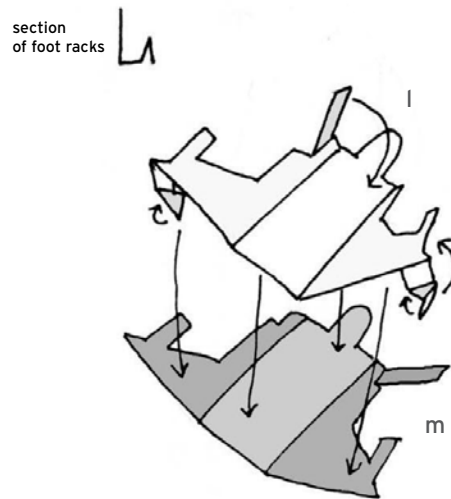


1. fold and glue together the seat pillows part



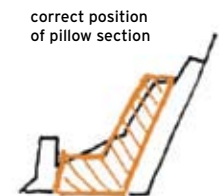
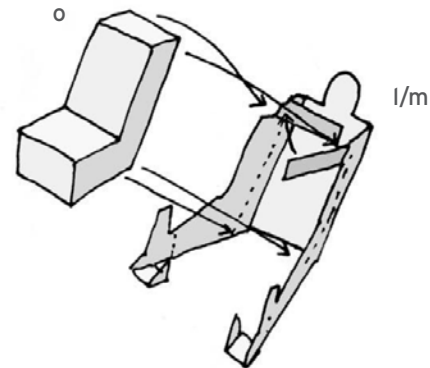
2. glue together the two parts of the ejection seat shell



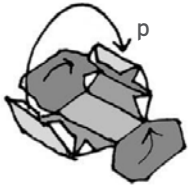
Q-5/A-5 one-seater cockpit instructions

Part designations use lowercase letters so they are not mixed up with parts of the aircraft model

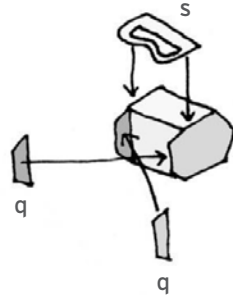
3. glue the pillows part into the shell, glue the two bars that stand out together, with one facing inward, the other outward



4. glue together the headrest



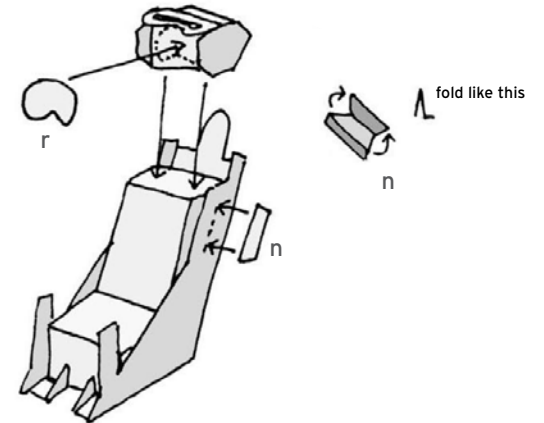
5. add side rests and face curtain



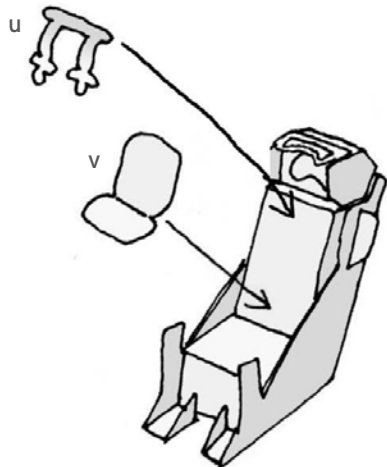
the face curtain can also be glued on backwards, for aircraft that are on the ground



6. glue headrest on the seat, add the pillow and side fin



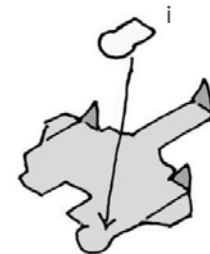
7. For Naval versions (PLNAF), glue on seat belts and life vest



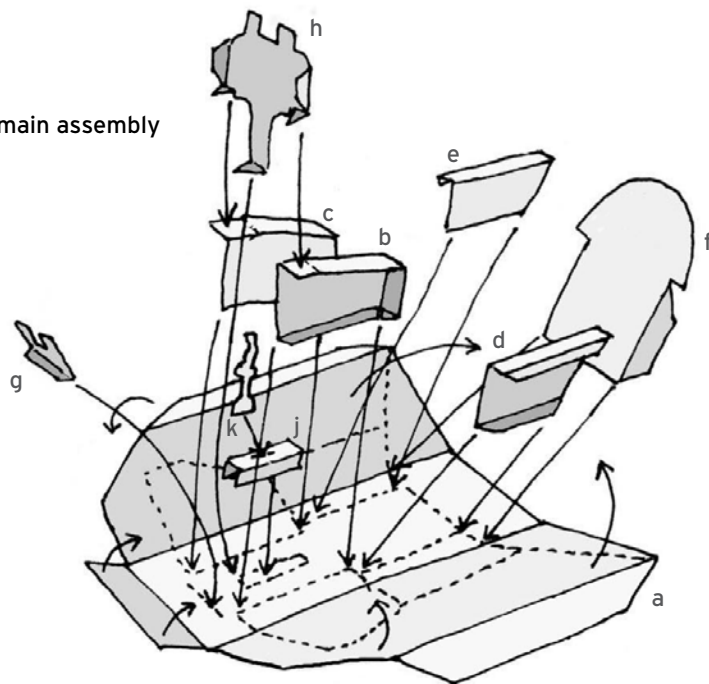
8. For all other versions, glue on seat belts



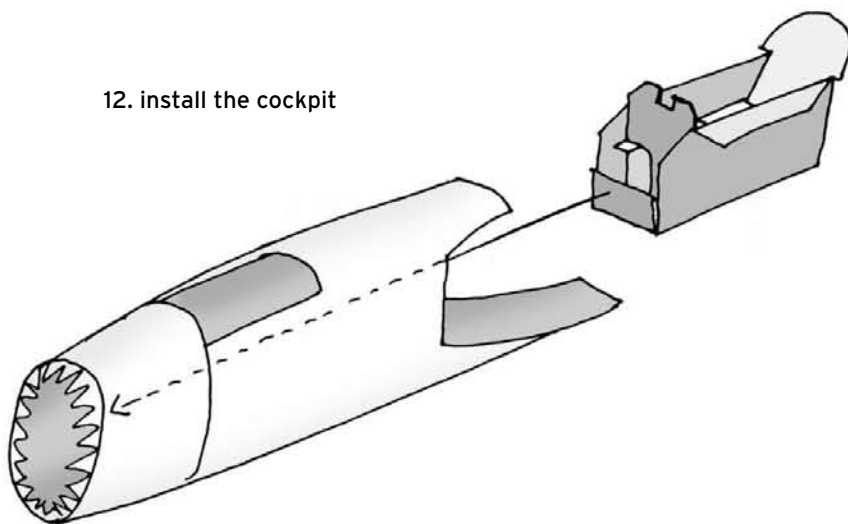
9. glue the altimeter rear cover on the back of the panel
