

# Hawker / Armstrong-Whitworth Sea Hawk

The Sea Hawk was one of the first jet fighters to enter service with the Royal Navy. Initially designed as a fighter, it served mostly as a ground attack aircraft, famously in the Suez Crisis as well as in a number of wars between India and Pakistan. It was a reliable and rugged workhorse.
