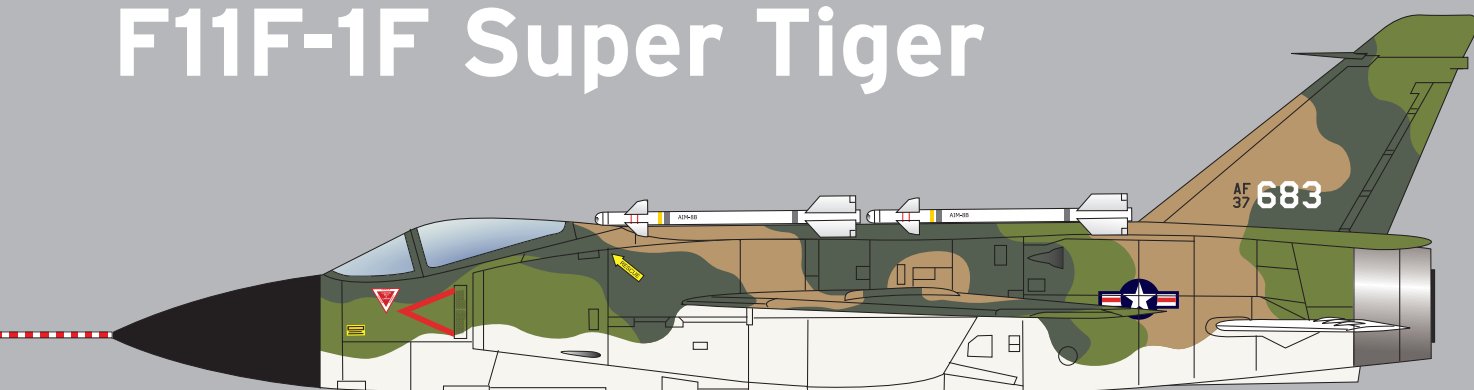

# Grumman F11F-1F Super Tiger

The F11F-1F Super Tiger was an improved version of the F11F with a stronger engine and improved aerodynamics, including a new nose, new air intakes and an area-ruled fuselage for more stable supersonic flight. It was said to have been faster and more manouverable than the basic model. Two prototypes were built. While being considered by the USAF as well as foreign operators, it eventually lost the contracts to Lockheeds F-104 Starfighter.
